COURSE DESCRIPTION

Day 1

Day 1 consists of a competitive scenario-driven event for up to ten teams. This complex scenario is based on a Florida-based incident full of interesting learning objectives for crisis negotiation teams. Teams will be judged by experienced peers and subject matter experts using a 10-category format including 'Intelligence Management', 'Communication', 'Risk Assessments', and 'Documentation'.

All teams will be competing using the same scenario and judging criteria. Teams are limited to 8 persons each, but teams are encouraged to bring as many people as they would like. Additional team members may observe other teams, assist in facilitation, participate as role players, or serve as judges. Each team must provide one experienced person to the judge's pool.
